5-10 founding students	Start small and grow!
Space to plant trees	A garden, fence line, or open field
A few seedlings	Start with indigenous species like Moringa, Mukau, or African Olive
Tools	Basic tools like jembes, trowels, and watering cans
Club notebook or tracker	For recording growth, rainfall, species planted, and events
